Welcome to the Indian Reservation Roads Program Web site. The Assistant Secretary for Indian Affairs, Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Division of Transportation (DOT), and the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) under the Deputy Assistant Secretary - Management are pleased to announce the Integrated Transportation Information Management System (ITIMS) will be made available to Tribal users on the web site.

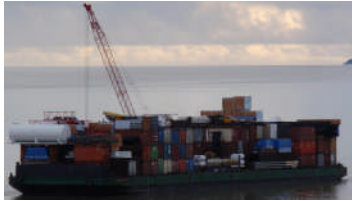
The DOT works closely with the Tribes using ITIMS data to coordinate, manage, and report on the usage of highway funds, which amount to about \$25 million from the BIA and \$300 to \$400 million in federal highway contributions. The new connectivity solution was developed specifically for the sharing of transportation data between BIA and the Tribes, and will provide Tribal members with access to a version of ITIMS to enter data and generate reports. ITIMS records do not include individual vehicle travel data (ITIS). This allows the BIA and the Tribes to use data effectively and efficiently using the ITIMS system and the data shared between them.

The DOT will utilize regional office staff working closely with Tribes on a day to day basis to get the information out. DOT has been in contact with Tribal entities and formed a training workgroup that consists of Tribal Transportation Staff, Tribal Technical Assistance Program Staff, Local Tribal Technical Assistance Staff, and Regional and Agency Transportation Staff to deliver the training and communicate to Tribal entities that the system and web site is available.
